The National Coalition of 100 Black Women (NCBW), Inc., Richmond Metropolitan Area Chapter, announce our annual Phenomenal Women Scholarship. There will be two scholarship recipients. The recipients must be full time undergraduate students at either VUU or VSU or a resident of the Richmond Metropolitan Area attending any 4 Year Historically Black College or University. This is a one-time only scholarship that will be awarded to the selected students upon receipt of all required materials. Students should review the attached information and ensure that all requirements are met. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Please carefully review each aspect of the application and complete accordingly. All application materials must be postmarked no later than **March 15th, 2019** . Scholarship recipients will be notified the second week of April and will be presented with the scholarship during our 4th Annual Phenomenal Women Gala on April 13, 2019 at The Omni Richmond Hotel in Richmond, Virginia.



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National Coalition of 100 Black Women, Richmond Metropolitan Area Chapter Phenomenal Women Scholarship Application Requirements

GOAL: The goal of the Phenomenal Women Scholarship is to provide educational funding support to women, especially women of color, which will assist applicants in achieving lifelong educational goals.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: Two \$2, 000 Scholarships awarded to full time undergraduate women scholars from either Virginia State University, Virginia Union University or resident of Richmond Metropolitan Area attending any 4 Year Historically Black College or University.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Undergraduate applicants must have a cumulative MINIMUM GPA of 2.7 on a 4.0 scale;
2. Applicant must complete the application in its entirety. **Applications that are not filled out completely will not be considered.**
3. Applicant must provide **ONE ORIGINAL** transcript from their institution.
4. Applicant must provide **ONE** letter of recommendation from a professor or administrator (such as a Department Chair or Dean) that is drafted on official university letterhead.
5. Applicant must submit a 500 word essay on the following: **What are your future goals and how will you incorporate your goals to advocate on the behalf of women and girls in one or more of the following areas: health, education or economic empowerment? *ALL ESSAYS SHOULD BE TYPED AND DOUBLED SPACED***
6. Please submit with the application a recent photo (a headshot or other appropriate picture) for use in our publication of this program. Photo will not be returned.
7. Application must be postmarked by **March 15th, 2019** to be considered. The Phenomenal Women Scholarship Committee will review all applications and notify applicants of their status on or before the first week in April. The selected scholarship recipients will be recognized at our on April 13th, 2019 at the 4th Annual Phenomenal Women Gala at The Omni Richmond Hotel in Richmond, Virginia.
