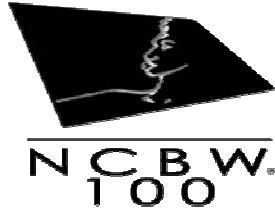

The National Coalition of 100 Black Women (NCBW), Inc., Richmond Metropolitan Area Chapter, announces our annual Phenomenal Women Scholarship. There will be two scholarship recipients. The recipients must be full time undergraduate students at either VUU or VSU or a resident of the Richmond Metropolitan Area attending any 4-Year Historically Black College or University (HBCU). This is a one-time only scholarship that will be awarded to the selected students upon receipt of all required materials. Students should review the attached information and ensure that all requirements are met. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Please carefully review each aspect of the application and complete accordingly. All application materials must be postmarked no later than May 30, 2020. Awardee will be notified at the start of the Fall 2020 semester. Notification of the scholarship recipient will be based upon the opening of the HBCU college or university.



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Phenomenal Women Scholarship Application Requirements

GOAL: The goal of the Phenomenal Women Scholarship is to provide educational funding support to women, especially women of color, which will assist applicants in achieving lifelong educational goals.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: Two \$500.00 Scholarships awarded to full time undergraduate women scholars from either Virginia State University, Virginia Union University, or resident of Richmond Metropolitan Area attending any 4 Year Historically Black College or University.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Undergraduate applicants must have a cumulative **MINIMUM** GPA of 2.7 on a 4.0 scale.
2. Applicant must complete the application in its entirety. Applications not filled out completely will not be considered.
3. Applicant must provide **ONE ORIGINAL** transcript from their institution.
4. Applicant must provide **ONE** letter of recommendation from a professor or administrator (such as a Department Chair or Dean) that is drafted on official university letterhead.

5. Applicant must submit a 500- word essay on the following: What are your future goals and how will you incorporate your goals to advocate on the behalf of women and girls in one or more of the following areas: health, education or economic empowerment? *ALL ESSAYS SHOULD BE TYPED AND DOUBLED SPACED*

6. Please submit with the application a recent photo (a headshot or other appropriate picture) for use in our publication of this program. Photo will not be returned.

7. Application must be postmarked by May 30, 2020 to be considered. The Phenomenal Women Scholarship Committee will review all applications and notify applicants at the start of the Fall 2020 semester. Notification of the scholarship recipient will be based upon the opening of the HBCU college or university.

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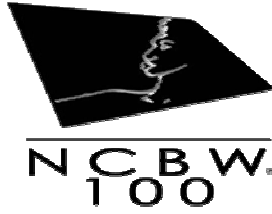
